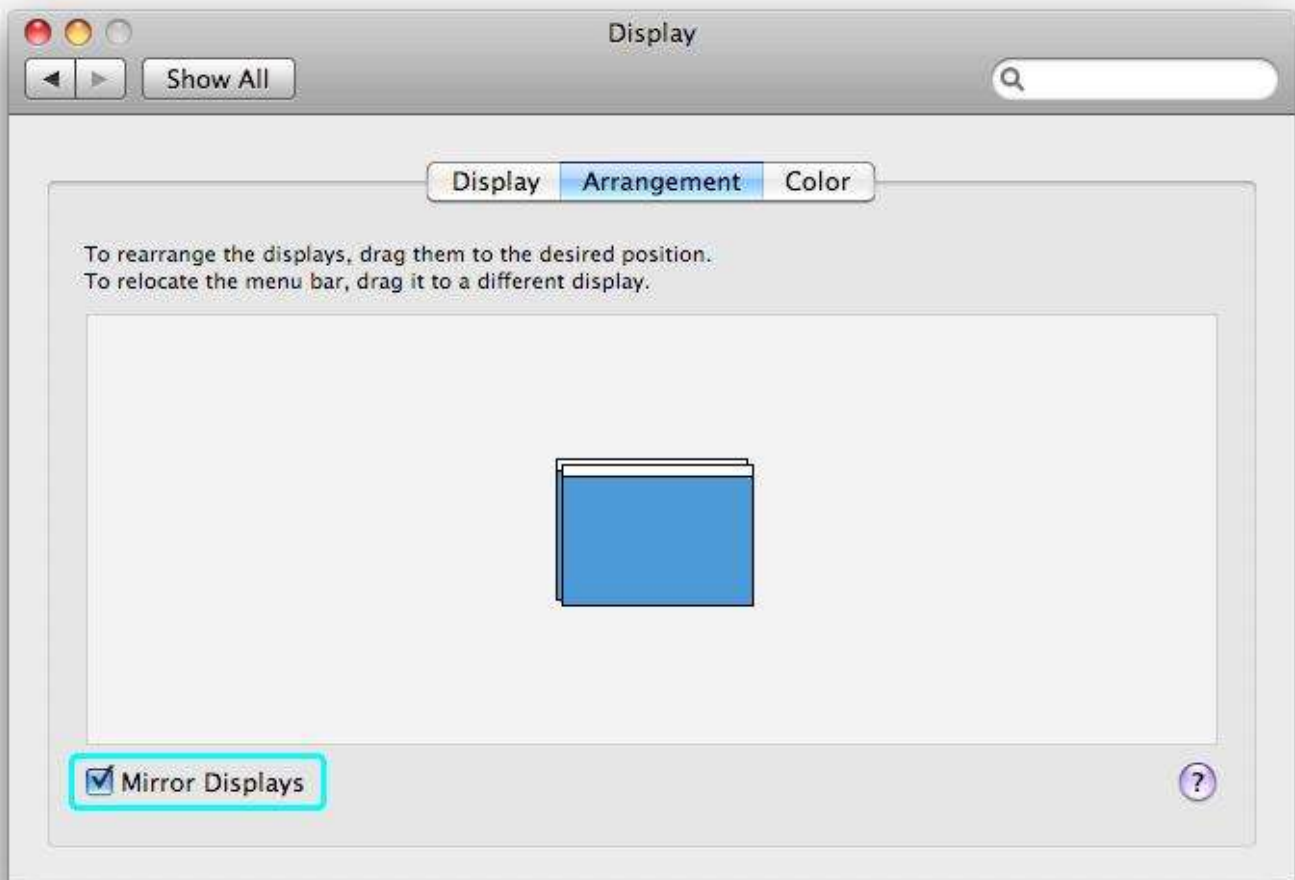
To use HDMI, turn on the projector and press the “Laptop HDMI” button. Connect the following cables to the laptop:



Note: An adapter may be required to connect the HDMI cable to the Mac.

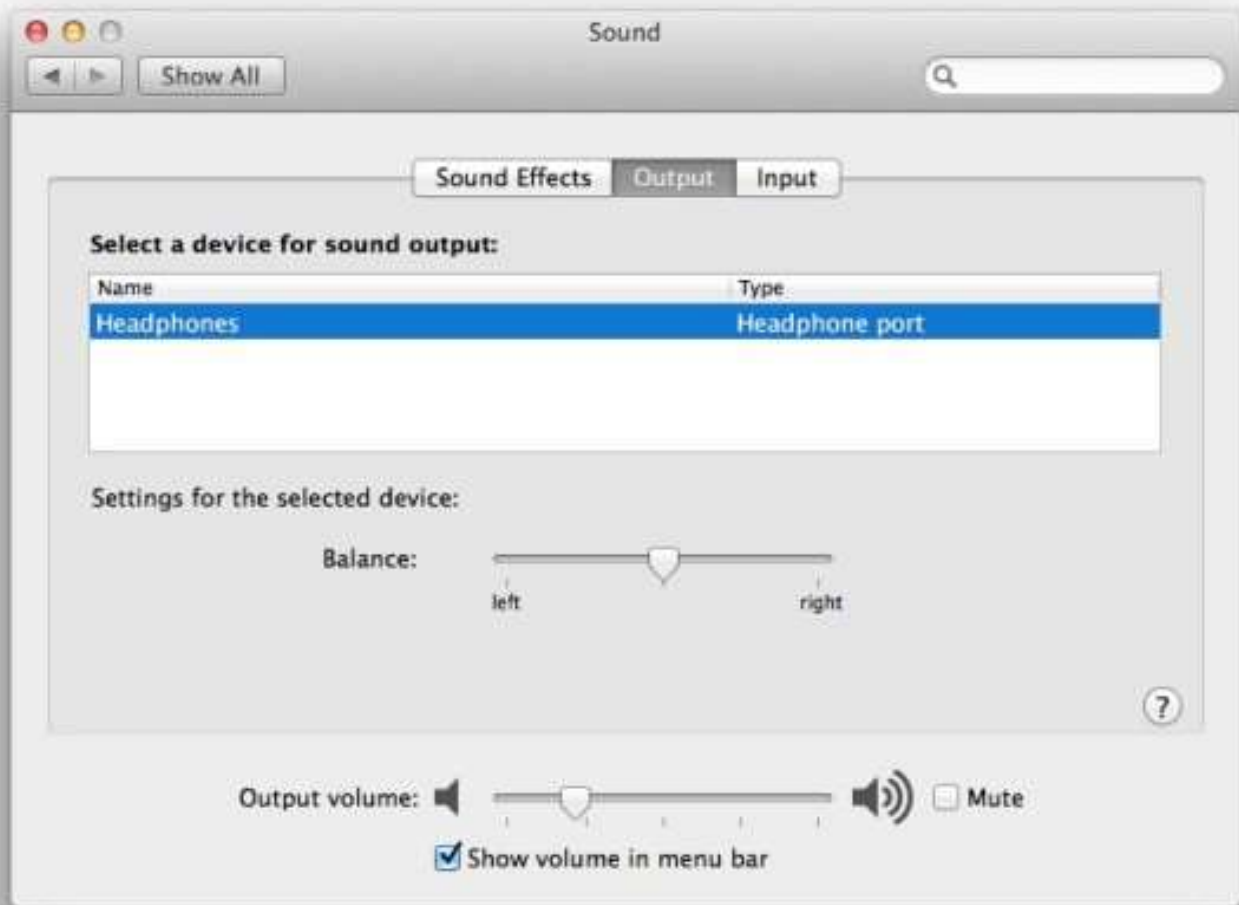
To duplicate or extend the laptop screen to the projector:

Go to System Preferences->Display->Arrangement. Check “Mirror Displays” to mirror the Mac monitor with the projector. Uncheck “Mirror Displays” to extend the Mac monitor onto the projector.



To set the audio output:

Go to System Preferences->Sound->Output. Ensure the “Headphones” output is selected.



VGA

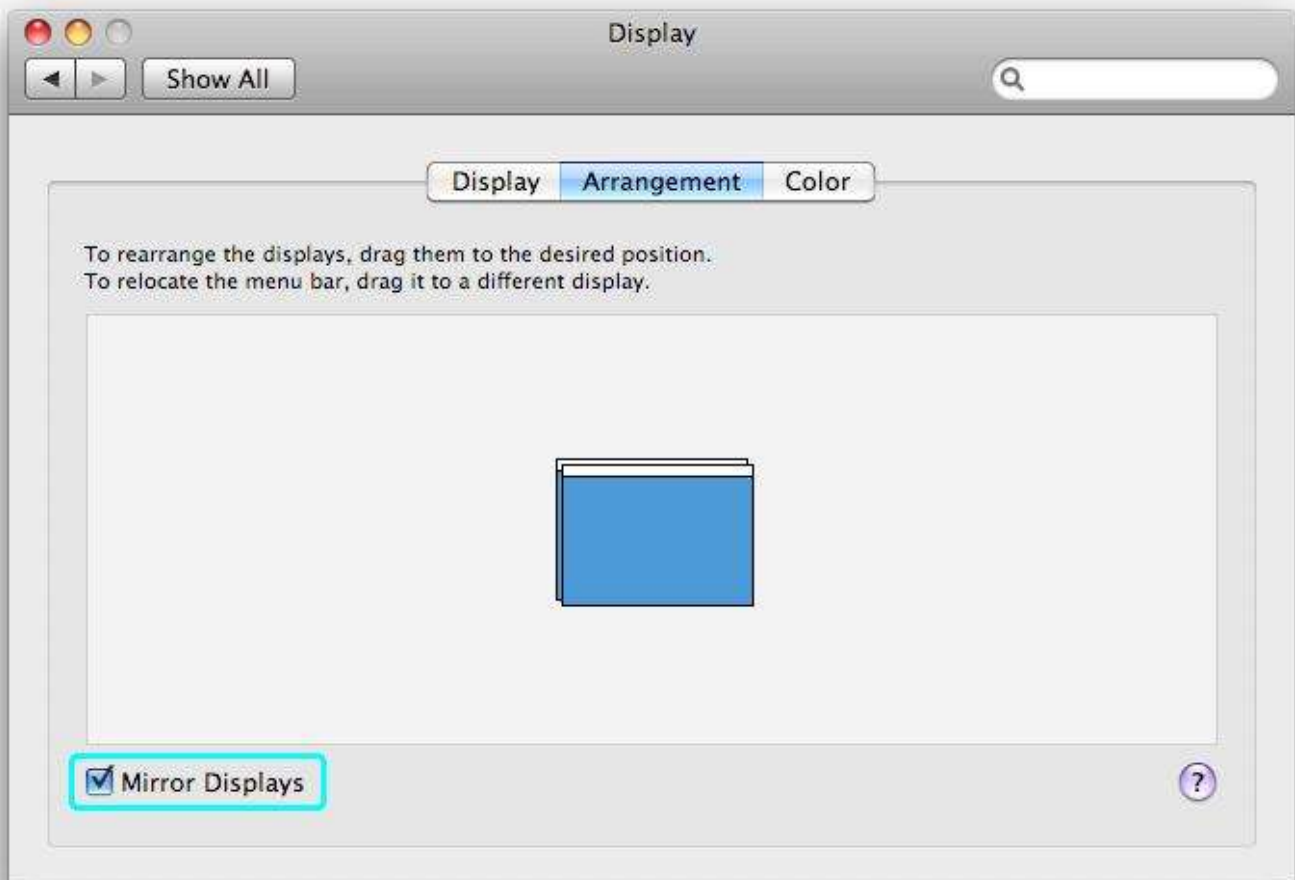
To use VGA, turn on the projector and press the “Laptop VGA” button. Connect the following cables to the laptop:



Note: An adapter may be required to connect the VGA cable to the Mac.
