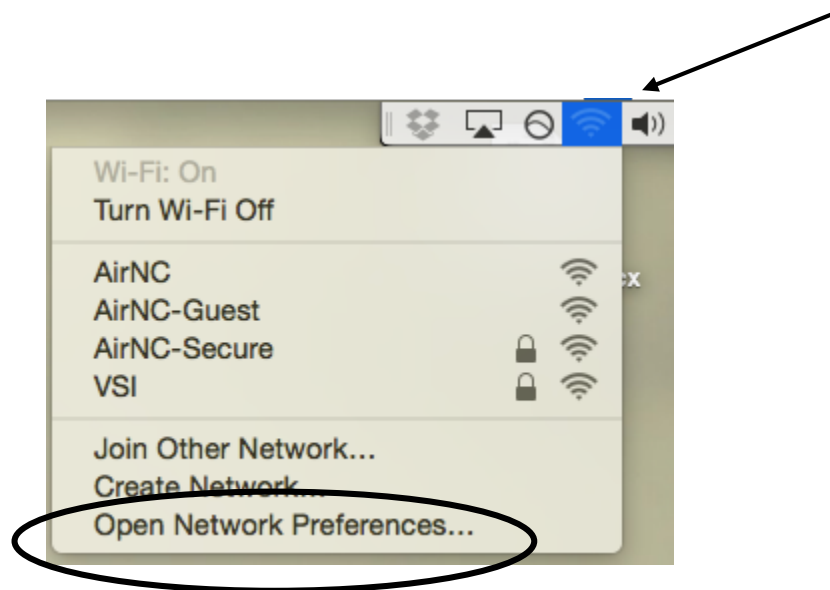


Connecting to Air NC-Secure Instructions (Mac OSX)

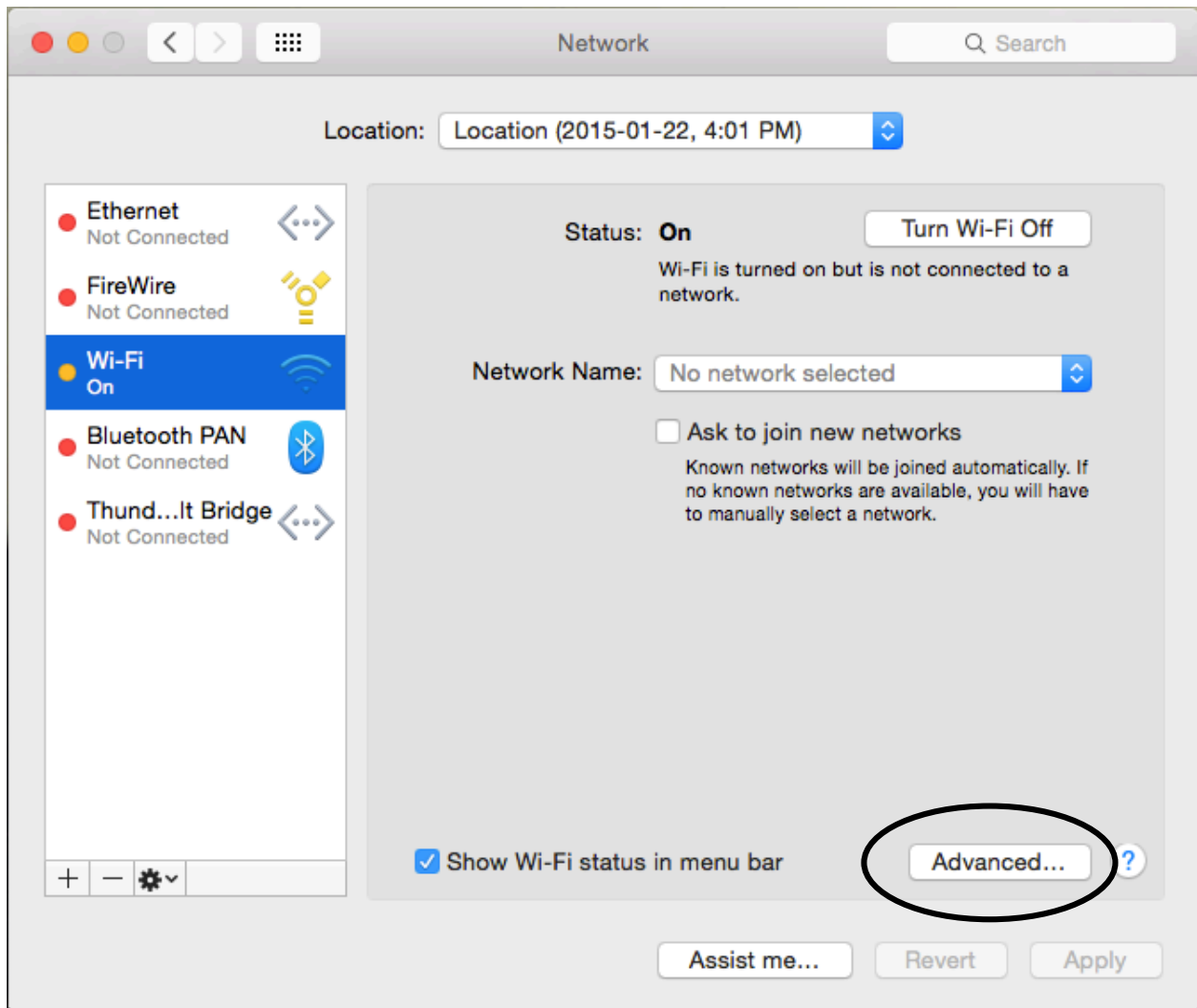
This document is for users who have recently changed their passwords or are unable to connect to AirNC-Secure and have successfully connected in the past.

This document will walk you through on how to delete a Wireless Profile and successfully reconnect to AirNC-Secure.

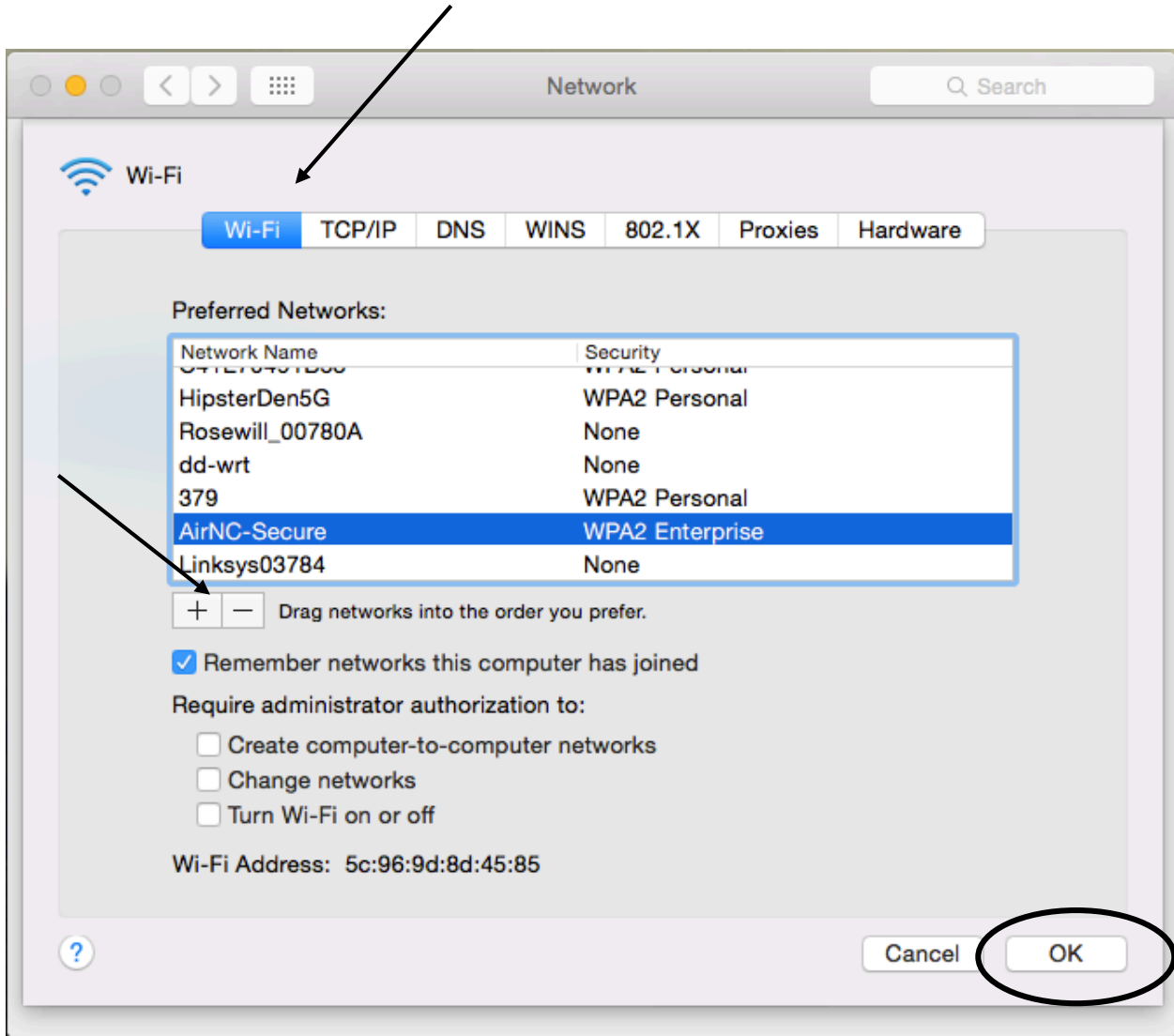
Click on the Wi-Fi icon located on the right-hand side of the top Menu bar. Then click on '*Open Network Preferences...*'.



If you are currently connected to a network, please click on 'Disconnect'. Then you will click on 'Advanced...' in the bottom right-hand of the window.



Make sure the 'Wi-Fi' tab is selected at the top. Under the 'Preferred Networks:' section, locate 'AirNC-Secure' and click on it. With 'AirNC-Secure' selected click on the minus icon to delete the saved wireless profile. Then click on 'OK'. Then click on 'Apply' on the Network window.



Click on the Wi-Fi icon on the top menu bar and select 'AirNC-Secure' to connect to it.



It will ask you to input your Username and Password. Please enter your Niagara College (Blackboard) Username and Password. Then click on 'Join'.



You should now be connected to the *AirNC-Secure* network. To check that you are connected, click on the Wi-Fi icon on the top menu bar and locate *AirNC-Secure*. There should now be a checkmark next to *AirNC-Secure*.
