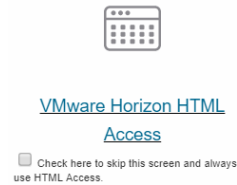


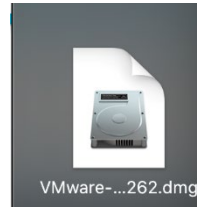
4. Locate the appropriate download for MacOS

6. Click Download

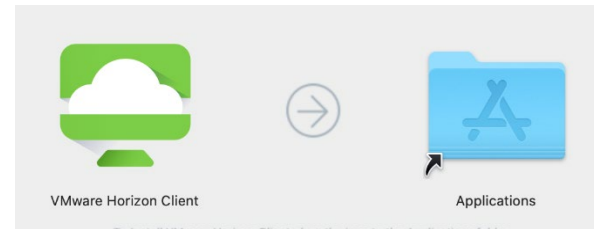


7. Navigate to the Downloaded File and double click it



8. Click: Agree and then Continue

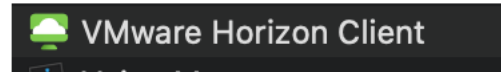
9. Drag the VMware Horizon Client to the application folder

1. Open the VMware Horizon Application



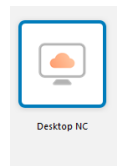
2. You may be asked to type in your MacOS admin Password please type this in

5. Login with your Blackboard username and Password
