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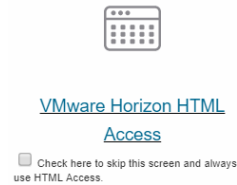

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## Web Access

### How To install the Application

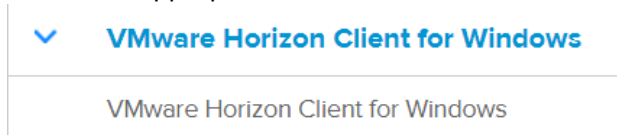
The preferred option of using virtual machines is to download the full application. Please follow the steps below on how to use it

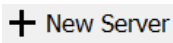
## Using the App

Once the app is installed follow the steps below to set it up.

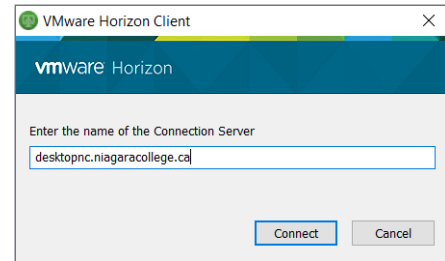
1. Open the VMware Horizon Application



2. Click Add Server **+ New Server**

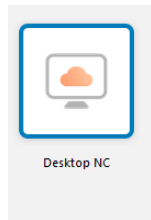


3. Type in desktopnc.niagaracollege.ca and click Connect
